Networking Activities

Career Exposure Series

Description: To enrich members’ career exposure, diverse career development opportunities including exclusive internships, trainee programmes, and Human Talent Library sharing will be organised.

Description: To organise non-academic excursions outside Hong Kong to enrich scholars’ experiences alongside strengthening the bond within the scholars’ community.
